Moorhead Police Summer Youth Program Code of Conduct

- **I will be respectful to Mentors and my peers.**
- **I will keep my hands to myself.** I understand no physical violence or aggression will be tolerated. This includes hitting, slapping, pushing, spitting, pulling hair, etc. This includes even if you are “playing around” or “play fighting.” This will result in your 1 strike/chance. If it happens again, you will be dismissed from the program.
- **I will not bully or harass another person.** The Summer Youth Program is a bully-free zone and this behavior will not be tolerated.
- **I will listen and not talk when we have a guest speaker, or when a Mentor is addressing the group.** If a guest speaker or Mentor is talking, they should be the only ones. If you are being asked to respond to a question, that is allowable and encouraged, but then you must quiet down when instructed.
- **I will follow directions given to me by any Mentor.**
- **I will stay with my assigned group at all activities.** Walking or running away from your group and/or the program will result in immediate dismissal from the program.
- **I will throw my garbage away.** Be a good example and pick up any garbage you see on the ground whether it’s yours or not.
- **I will always leave my lanyard on.** Don’t play with your lanyard as this can result in it breaking.
- **I will follow bus safety rules.** Listen to the bus driver and any Mentors while on the bus. This is for your safety and the safety of others.
- **I will be on my best behavior to ensure the Summer Youth Program is fun for all!**
